2. Read Isaiah 6: 1-6
  - a. Review the condition of Uzziah's reign in 2 Chronicles 26. What was the general condition of the culture?
  - b. Who was the main focus of Isaiah's vision? What was the setting?
  - c. What can you glean from Isaiah's vision about God? What does it say about God's character?
  - d. How does this vision contrast from the current culture in ancient times, what about our current culture?
  - e. What does it mean that God is holy?
  - f. What happened to the temple?
  - g. Why did Isaiah have unclean lips?
  - h. How did God solve his guilt and sin problem?
  - i. What do these scriptures teach about the Lord?
3. Read Luke 5:4-8
  - a. What did Jesus suggest to Simon following his message?

- b. What was Simon's response?
- c. What happened when Simon obeyed and he lowered his nets into the water?
- d. How did Simon respond when he saw his nets tearing?
- e. Who are you in the small moments when no one is looking?
- f. How do you define integrity?
- g. Why did Simon Peter ask Christ to leave him because of the nets tearing?
