**Warming up**

2. Read 1 Kings 16:29-33.
  - a. What does this say about King Ahab?
  - b. Who is Jezebel?
  - c. What does it mean to worship Baal?
3. Read 1 Kings 17:1,
  - a. What does God do to get Ahab's attention?
  - b. When was the last time God got your attention? Talk about it.
  - c. What happened? (Extra Credit: Read the rest of chapter 17!)
4. Read 1 Kings 18.
  - a. What is the difference between the attitude of Obadiah and King Ahab when they met Elijah?
  - b. Why do you think Ahab did not turn to God after this miracle?
5. Read 1 Kings 20:13-43.
  - a. What happened?

- b. How did Ahab respond?
  - c. What kind of obedience does God ask of us?
6. Read 1 Kings 21:1-25 & 1 Kings 22:13-53
- a. What do you think about Jezebel?
  - b. What do you see in these passages?
