Warming up

1. How far was it from Jerusalem to Emmaus? How long would it take you to walk it? How long would it take your friend who is carrying 50lbs of books, headed against the wind, has a limp, going uphill? Extra credit :)

Digging Deeper & Application

Take your time reading the scripture given. If possible look up the verses in different versions and pause at each verse and discuss it.

2. Read Luke 24:13-34. Take your time.
 - What is the first thing God shows you? Talk about it with your group.
 - Who were these two people?
 - What were their names?
 - Were they part of the original 12 apostles?
 - What do you think about verse 16?
 - What does that mean to you?
 - Is it possible for people to be spiritually blind?
3. These two people were, "walking along" between Jerusalem and Emmaus. Do you think they expected a miracle? Do you think they expected to see Jesus?
4. Pastor Ruben said we can get hung up on the destination and miss what God is doing today. Have you ever been guilty of looking ahead and not recognizing what God wants to do in the present?
5. Pastor Ruben said, "God cares more about your journey than your destination." What did Moses learn about God and himself as he journeyed to the Promise Land?
6. "Your greatest revelations of God will come not from your destination, but on that dusty road as you walk along." What have you learned about yourself and God as you have been in the inbetween of life?
7. Most people turn to God because they need a change of circumstances. They turn to God with a "To Do" list for God. You always come to God as a sufferer needing help. You don't come as a sinner needing redemption. Do you see yourself as someone who desperately needs redemption?
8. What did Jesus use to explain who He was with these two travelers?
9. Read Luke 24:35-49. What jumps out at you?

10. What has God shown you in the story of The Road to Emmaus?
