Warming up

1. What is your favorite time of year?

Digging Deeper & Application

Take your time reading the scripture given. If possible look up the verses in different versions and pause at each verse and discuss it.

2. To understand the life of Moses, it's important to see the history. Please read Genesis 47:1-6. Exodus 1; and Exodus 2:1-10; 23-25.
 - How many Hebrews moved to Egypt?
 - What was the name of the town the Hebrews lived?
 - Why was the new Pharaoh afraid of the Hebrews?
 - Share any additional thoughts. What does the name, "Moses" mean?
3. Please read Exodus 3:1-11. How did God get Moses' attention?
 - Did Moses know God at a personal level? Explain.
 - What does God ask of Moses? What is Moses' question to God in verse 11?
 - What does this say about how Moses felt about himself?
4. According to Exodus three, how many times does Moses protest God's choice to use him?
5. Pastor Ruben said, it wasn't about "Who am I", it was about "Who I AM".
 - How are these two phrases different?
 - As you look at the life of Moses, how was God showing Moses who He was?
6. How does this relate to our own life? How do we wrestle with "who am I", when God wants us to see "Who He Is?"

7. There are seven I AM statements that Jesus mentioned. Where are they? Don't google it. Find them on your own!
